Discus - Best Flight First (75-Minute, 3 Throws, + Finals)

Shot Put - Best Flight Last (75-Minute, 3 Throws + Finals)

High Jump- Best Flight First - F1 Opening Height 1.70 (5' 7"); F2 1.55 (5' 1")

Pole Vault- Best Flight First - F1 Opening Height 3.05 (10'); F2 - 2.45 (8')

INFORMATION:

1. The meet will be governed by IHSA Track and Field Rules and National Federation rules concerning uniforms. Contestants may enter in four events.
2. Submit your entries on athletic.net by 5:00 pm on April 17th. USE THIS YEAR'S TIME AND DISTANCES ONLY. HEATS WILL BE SET UP AND WILL NOT BE CHANGED FOR LATE ENTRIES OR SUBSTITUTIONS. For your information, print out your entries after you submit them.
3. On track and runway ¼" or less pyramid spikes.
4. Starting blocks will be provided. You are welcome to bring your own.
5. Teams should set up outside the fence around the track. Athletes should stay outside the fence unless they are competing.
6. Please listen for Announcement of events, so that we can stay on time.
7. Athletes are asked to report to the Clerk of the Course at the bullpen, which will be located on the 50 yard line in the middle of the football field. Numbers will also be given to athletes at this site for FAT Timing.
8. Teams should come dressed to compete; locker rooms will not be available.
9. Do not wear spikes in bleachers.
